

Michael Lomen Gym Dedication

February 4, 2022 marked a special day in Eagle Rock High School History. Originally called the Boys' Gym, the building was officially renamed as the Michael Lomen Gymnasium. Many of the Lomen family came to see the dedication ceremony, which occurred before the Varsity Girls' Basketball game. Bill Whiting, former student (Summer '71) and coach, shared a brief biography of Coach Lomen. Having five daughters, Coach Lomen was an advocate for Girls' athletics, which became a reality in the 1970s. Michele (Lomen) Rendler, shared some memories of her father to the audience. Lomen Gym is the first building on the Eagle Rock campus to be named after an individual. It is the second oldest building on the campus, the auditorium being the oldest structure. In 2019, a major renovation project began to seismically retrofit





Lomen Gym. Additional upgrades were made to the gym, including new lockers, gym floor, bleachers, air conditioning, and lighting. The only other facility named after an individual on campus is the Don Mengel Athletic Field. Special appreciation goes to the Associated Student Body and Varsity Cheerleading Squad for providing a celebratory environment to the event.
